THE 1977 NATIONALS WERE HELD IN FLORA ILLINOIS, JULY 27th THEO JULY 30th, AT THE CLD SAVENGS AND LOAN SUILDING IN DOWNTONN FLORA ILLINOIS, THE SIZE AND SETUP OF THE SUILDING WAS ABOUT PROPERLY ON A MAKE OF THE THEORY AT MAKE, THE SO EXTRICS WERE STONED BY, TWO LESS THAN AND MAKE IN LOSS SAYING THEY WERE PLANNING ON BEING THERE, SIX STATES AND CANADA REPROBENTED SOME OF THE BEST NAMES IN M.O. BANGEST.

ALL IN ALL EVERYTHING WAS A ADY AS THE RACERS REGAN TO ARRIVE. STEVE SHOWN AND THEN HITCHCOX FROM MIGHIGAN MERS. THE FIRST TO ARRIVE, JUST SEPONDE THE TACK WAS NET UP, SHOWNED WAS TO BE SUPE HE WAS READY.

THE NATIONALS TRACK NEVER CLOSED PHON WID., DRU SAT, RACE DAY, PRACTICE WAS NOT AND HEAVY FOR MANY EN OF THE RACERS, MED-CAME AND WENT AT BELL HEARS OF THE DAY AND NIGHT.

HAGE DAY WAS UPON US BEFORE WE EXEM IT, AND ALL THE MACERS WHEE DOING THE LAST MENUTE ADJUSTMENTS THEY HOPED WOULD TAKE THEM TO THE MAIN. TOCAL INSPORTION WENT SMOOTH, WITH ALL POINTS BEING CHECKED ON ALL ENTELES, BY MASSON OR AND PENNINGTON, JOEL HAD RECOGHT ALONG A METER TO CHECK MAGNETS AND ALL CARS WERE CHECKED INSIDE AND OUT.

RACING AND CONCOUR THIS PAST YEAR... HIS NEATNESS AND AUTHENTIC CARS ARE FINE. JAY SARRINENS CAR GRABBED THIRD, PLACE, JAY HAD DONE A GREAT AMOUNT OF WORK ON HIS KEKEK. ENDLY, BUT NOT QUITE ENOUGH. FORTH PLACE WENT TO MIKE CAUDLE OF FLARA. AND FIFTER TO HENSON SR OF FLORA, WITH A HRIND PREPPED BODY.

TIME TRIALS WERE NEXT, AND AFTER A SHORT BREAK, HERB BENSON JR STARTED IT OFF SY BREAKING THE STANDING TRACK RECORD WITH A BUN OF 12.35. HERB HEMSON SK., THEN BROKE IT AGAIN WITH A 12.40 RUN, BUT THE BEST WAS YET TO COME, AS JOEL PENNINGTON STEPPED UP MOFILET FLOW TO A RECORD SHATTERING RUN OF WOULD YOU BELLEVE 1437. HIS GAR WAS A BLUE, REUGE GABENER HAD A GOOD RUN OF 13.35, RECEINED HOUSE FOR A STRONG SECOND IN THE TRIALS, AND BRUCE SCHMITT JUNEED IN AND TURNED A GOOD 12.41 FOR THERD FASTEST.....

THE HEAT RACES WERE NEXT ON THE AGENDA, AND THE FOUR GRID SET UP WAS TO HE USED, WITH FOUR SINIS AND TWO SUPER SINIS, AND ONE WAIN. ONLY DHE FOUR SINIS WILL BE COVERED, I HAD TO START THERE SECAUSE OF APMOBLEM WITH SPACE AND SO ON. I WISH ALL THE RACES COULD HAVE BEEN COVERED UP TO THE SINIS.

THE FIRST SIMI ON THE A SIDE MATCHED JOEL PENNINGTON, KEVIN SHEEDAN, MERB HENSON JR, AND TERRY HERNO. SHEEDAN HAD MOVED ALL THE WAY UP FROM THE FIRST HEAT OF THE DAY TO THE SIMI. JOHL MOVED OUT EARLY TO LEAD, 25 TO 24 OVER HENSON JR, AT THE END OF ONE HEAT. SHEEDAN HAD 20, AND HERNO 19. PENNINGTON AND HERSON JK BOTH BECAN TO FULL AMAY IN THE SECOND HEAT, AND BOTH KEPT IT UP TO TAKE THE NOVEUPS. JOHL WINNING THE HEAT 101 TO 89 FOR HERD JR.KEVIN SHEEDAN THIED WITH 74-41, AND BY THIS TIME HE HAD DONE A FULL DAYS RACING, AND HERNO HAD PROBLEMS AND ENDED WITH 62-33......

THE B SIME WAS KIND OF A FAMILY APPAIR, BEUCE GARDNER, GREG GARDNER, NORMAN GARDNER, AND A YOUNG 13 YEAR OLD FRON FLORA, ROBBIE MINSON, BRUCE HAD QUALIFIED SECOND, AND NORM SIXTH, SO BOTH WERE THE FAVORITES FOR THIS RAGE, BRUCE AND NORM MADE THE GOOSMAKERS CORRECT BY FULLING AWAY, BOTH MAYING 22 LAPS AT THE END OF ONE, BRUCE PICKED UP 4 ON NORM IN THE SECOND HEAT WITH MINSON 11 BEHIND THE LEADER, BRUCE ADDED MORE LAPS ON NORM AT THE END, AND MON WITH 92 LAPS, NORM SECOND WITH 81, MINSON THIRD WITH 66-46, GREG FOURTH WITH 62-64.

DIE C SIMI WAS A RACE FROM START TO PINISH, SRICE SCHMITT, RANDY KEMP, JOHN SCHMIDT, AND KIN BARTHOLOMEN, FROM THE WORD GO BRUCK, RANDY AND KIN WERK PLYING, AND AT THE END OF CHE, SCHHETT HELD A LEAD WITH 23, RANDY 22, AND KIN 21. JOHN SCHRIDT HAD PROSLEDS AND COULD ONLY TURN 7 IN THE FIRST SEG. RANDY, BRUCE, AND KIN DICED BACK AND POURTH AND AT THE END OF 2, DRUCE WAS STILL UP 46 TO 44 CYER MANDY, KIN WAS ONE BACK WITH 43, THE THIRD HEAT REALLY MADE THINGS TOUGH AS KIN MADE HIS MOVE AND TOOK OVER THE LEAD 67 TO 67 FOR KEMP, MRUCE STYED CLOSE WITH 66. THE LAST SEG. TOLD THE TALE AS KEMP HIT A TOUGH LANK AND FOURTH KIN RIGHT UP TO THE FINAL SECOND, THED POR SECOND. BRUCE SCHMITT HAD PULLED OUT A 2 LAP LEAD AND WON THE HEAT. BARTHOLOMEN HELD OFF KEMP, IN A CLOSE FINISH, 35 TO 87-37. JOHN SCHMIDT WHO HAD EARLY PROBLEDS FINISHED AT 55-32.

THE D SIMI WAS STEVE BROWN, HERB HENSON SR, TONY DOTY, AND AL THURMAN.
THIS HEAT ALSO STARTED LIKE A BARN BURNER, AS BROWN AND HENSON AND DOTY
RAN OFF AND LEFT THURMAN., TONY BOTY LED AT ONE, 22TO 21 OVER HERSON
AND BUDNN. AT THE END OF TWO DOTY HAD BEGAN TO TAKE CHARGE RUNNING A
STRONG RACE, AND LEDM 44 TO 42 OVER HENSON. BROWN WAS THIRD WITH 41. THURMAN
LAST WITH 32. BAD LUCK WADE HIS APPEARANCE AGAIN, AS GOING INTO THE
THIRD HEAT DOTYS CAR GAVE OUT, AND ALL THE EFFORTS TO GET IT GOING WAS TO
NO AWAIL. BROWN HAD MOWED OUT AND GOT BY HENSON, AND AT THE END OF THERE,
LED HENSON 64 TO 63. THURMAN WAS TRYING TO GET BACK INTO IT, AND HAD
54. DOTY MAS OUT OF THE RACE. IN THE FINAL SEG, HENSON CAUGHT BROWN AND
HOVED OUT TO HIM NO TO NA.THURMAN THIRD 77-48, DOTY FOURTH 44-18.
INTO THE AGE SUPER SIMI, AND JOEL PENNINGTON, KIM BARTHOLOMEN, HELB
HENSON JR, AND BEGGE SCHRITT WOLE READY TO BATTLE IT OUT FOR THE MOVE
UPS TO THE MAIN, PENNINGTON THE \$1 QUALIFIER, BARTHOLOMEN 7th, HENSON JR
STID, AND SCHRITT 3PH MADE FOR A GOOD BACE.
MARCHOLOMEN SPECKED INTO THE BORE AS GOOD BACE.

MANUFOLDER SHOULD INTO THE EARLY LEAD, WITH 50 LAPS IN THE FIRST HEAT.

MENSON AS ANDSCHOOLT TIED FOR SHOOND WITH 48, PENNINGTON IN LAST AT THIS

TIME WITH 46, PENNINGTON DECIDED HE SETTER GET IT TOGATHER AND DID JUST

THAT, AS HE PASSED ALL CARS AND TOOK OVER THE LEAD, WITH 99 EAPS AT THE END OF TWO SECS, SCHMITT HELD ON TO SECOND WITH 97, BARTHOLOGEN THIRD WITH 93, AND HENSON JR WITH 93. JOHL AND EIM HELD ON TO THEME LEAD THRU THE THIRD SEG, JOEL WITH 148, AND BRUCE 143.KIN WAS THIRD AT 140, AND HENSON JR WITH 135. NOTHING CHANGED IN THE FINAL HEAT AS JOEL HELD ON TO WIN BY TWO OVER BRUCE, 196 TO 194. HENSON JR HAD GOT BY WARTHOLOGEN AS KIN HAD PROBLETS AND HENSON JR FINISHED THIRD WITH 178, TO KIMS 170. JOEL PENNINGTON AND BRUCE SCHMITT TO THE 1977 NATIONALS MAIN.

THE ASD SUPER SIMI WAS BRUCE GARDNER, STEVE SHOWN, HERB HINSON SR. AND NORMAN GARDNER, BRUCE WAS SECOND QUALIFIER, SHOWN EIGHDE, HENSON SR FOURTH, AND NORMAN SIXTH. AMOTHER GOOD MATCHUP FOR THE OTHER TWO HOVE UPS TO THE MAIN, THE FIRST HEAT STARTED FAST, AS HERSON SR NOVED OUT TO TAKE A EARLY LEAD, AS DROWNIE WAS HAVING PROBLEMS, MENSON SR LED AT THE END OF ONE, 49 TO 48 OVER NORM GARDNER, WITH SEIGE THIRD AT 36. HEGEN WAS OUT OF THE RACE WITH MECHANICAL PROBLEMS. THE SECOND HEAT WAS NORE OF THE FIRST, AS HENSON SR FULLED AWAY FROM GARDNER (NORM), TO LEAD BY FOUR AT THE END OF TWO SECS, 96TO 92. BRUCE GARDNER WAS NOW WAY DICK AND ENDED HEAT 🚟 TWO WITH SO LAIS, HEAT DORES WAS A SMOKER AS MORNAN FOUND THE COMBINATION AND SEGAN TO MOVE, AND MOVE HE DID AS HE CAUGHT HENSON SK AND TOOK OVER THE LEAD 145 TO 142, AS HENSON WAS HAVING PICKUP PROBLEMS, BRUCE ENDED THREE WITH 124, THE FINAL HEAT WAS ALL GARDNER, (NORM) AS HE HELD ON TO HIS LEAD OWER HENSON SE AND WON THE SUPER SIMI 196 TO 190 FOR HENSON SR. BRUCE GARDNER THIRD WITH 168-62, AND BROWN FOURTH, NUMBAN GARDNER AND HERS BENSON SR TO THE 1977 NATIONALS MAIN.

THE MAIN

HERE THEY WERE. THE TOP FORR DRIVERS IN THE 1977 NATIONALS, STANDING AT THEIR POSITIONS AND READY TO GO AT IT. JULL PENNINGTON FROM OAK PARK ILLINOIS, THE 1976 NATIONAL CHAMP, WITH MANY HONRA VICTORIES UNDER HIS BELT DURING THE LAST TWO YEARS, AND A EXCEPTIONAL CAR BUILDER, MAYBE THE HEST ANYMHERE. IN MY 14 YEARS OF MACING I HAVE SAW NO ONE ANY DETTER AT SETTING UP A SLOT CAR, TO RACE AND TO WIN.

HERE MENSON SR, FLORA ILLINOIS, STANDING NOT REALLY BELIEVING HE WAS
IN THE NAIN, IT HAD ALL HAPPENED SO FASTE, AND AGAIN HAVING A GAR SET
UP TO HANDLE AND PINISH PAID OFF FOR HENSON. IT HAD BEEN MANY YEARS OF
RAGING, MANY YEARS OF RUNNING THE LOCAL SLOT GLUS, MANY YEARS OF DRIVING
HUNDREDS OF MILES TO KEEP SHARP WITH THE BEST COMPETITION, AND NOW THE
BIG ONE, 14 YEARS OF RAMING, AND HE WAS IN THE FINALS. OF THE MATIGNALS.
BRUCE SCHMITT, FROM PARK FORREST ILLINOIS, DHE THIRD PASTENT QUALIFIER
AT THE NATIONALS, AND RUNNING AS GOODERTON AS ANYONE, BRUCE HAD RAN WELL
SINGE HE ARRIVED AT THE RACE, AND MAS A FAVORITE FROM THE START, BRUCE
IS A GOOD COMPETITOR, AND A HARD DRIVER, ANOTHER ONE OF THE TEAM HORNI
DRIVERS WHO GUTS YOU NO SLACK, BRUCE WAS HEADY.

NORMAIN GARDNER (STORMIN NORMAN) ONE OF THE FEW GUYS AROUND TO REALLY IMPRESS ME WITH HIS OVERALL SKILL TOWARD RACING, THE ACTUAL BUILDING PART OF IT, NORMAN DOES IT ALL, BUILDS HIS OWN CARS, WINDS HIS OWN MOTOWS, AND USUALLY GOES FAST, FAST, HAS BIGGEST PROBLEM IS TEARING UP WHEN HE IS RUNNING REAL GREAT. MAYBE THIS WAS HIS DAY, HE HAS SEVERAL HOPRA WINS TO HIS CREDIT, AND ALSO HAS TO BE A FAVORITE.

KIR SHAW, RACE DIRECTOR FOR THE MAIN, SAID THE MAGIC WORDS AND THE FINALS WERE ON, WITH BRUCE SCHMITT GETTING AWAY FAST, FLAT FLYING, THE DRIVERS KIND OF SETTLED INTO A PATTERN OF THEIR OWN IN THE FIRST HEAT, EACH DRYING TO GET INTO THE GROVE, AND AT THE END OF ONE, BRUCE SCHMITT LED WITH 64, STOCKEN NORMAN SECOND WITH 61, FENNINGTON THERD AT 59, AND HENSEN SR IN FOUNDH WITH 57, THE SECOND SEG WAS TROUBLE AND SCHMITT BLEAN TO HAVE PROBLEMS, HE WAS LEADING AND BENNING EXCEPTIONAL WHEN THIS HAPPENED, HE BROCEVED OFF THE PACE AND HENSON SR GOT BY HIM, AS JOEL AND NORMAN WERE RACKING UP THE LAPS AS HEAT TWO ENDED WITH JOEL AND NORM TIED AT 125 EACH, HENSON SE IN THIRD WITH 119, AND SCHMITT FOURTH AT THEM 101.

IN THE DIED HEAT, NORM RUNNING IN BLUE LANG SEGAN TO MOVE, HE AND JUEL STRE HAVING SOME REAL LAPS TOGATHER, AND HENSON MAS FALLING BACK A LITTLE. THE 1977 NATIONAL CHAMPION, (STORMIN NORMAN) GARDNER.

ROBBLE MINSON SECOND IN NOVICE, HIS FIRST BIG RACE AND A GOOD ONE. THIS NOY HAS THE TOOLS TO BE A GOOD MACHE, HE FINISHED TWELTH OVERALL. THOM HITCHOOK THIRD IN NOVICE, HIS FIRST BIG RACE, AND A 17TH PARCE FINISH.

THEN IS A GOOD INTERESTED RACER, AND I ENJOYED MEETING HIM.
FRITZ ZIMMERNEN, FOURTH IN NOVICE AND A 21st PLACE FINISH. BIG Z WAY GET
IT ALL TOGATHER ONE OF THESE DAYS.

DAN HOTHWELL JR, THE YOUNGEST RACHE TO ENTER THE MATIONALS. #AND HE MAGES LIKE HE MEANS IT. HE HAS THE MAKING OF A PINE MAGER, AND WAS PRESENTED A SILVER CUP FROM A.J. FOR HIS EFFORT. IN PUTTING DHIS NATIONALS ISSUE TO BED, I HAVE A FEW COMMENTS FROM DHE RACE DIRECTERS STANDPOINT, CONCERNING THE SETTING UP AND HANDLING OF THE MATIONALS, ITS A HECK OF A LOT OF WORK, MONTHS OF PREPARATION, LETTERS TO SPONSORS, AND-SO ON, PLUS GETTING INFO TO EVERYONE, THE SECURING OF A DECENT SUILDING TO HOUSE THE RACE, INSURANCE, RENT, AND MUCH MORE BEHIND THE SCENNS WORK NOT NOTICED BY ANYONE.
